RESOLUTION NO. 06-2022

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE OHM ADVISORS AS CITY ENGINEER COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- **WHEREAS,** Council for the City of Reminderville has determined that there is a need to hire a firm for the engineering services for the City of Reminderville, and
- **WHEREAS**, Council finds that Orchard, Hiltz, & McCliment, Inc. dba OHM Advisors best meets the requirements and qualifications demanded of Council, and
- **NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:
- **SECTION 1.** That OHM is hereby hired as City Engineer for the term commencing January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024.
- **SECTION 2.** That all engineering and consulting performed by OHM shall be billed in accordance with the rate schedule, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof. Payments shall be made at the completion of this service or monthly under this Subsection upon the billing of the Engineer, furnished to the Fiscal Officer of the City of Reminderville.
- **SECTION 3.** That no person holding the office of the City Engineer shall participate as a private professional consultant for private clients within the corporate limits when such engineering plans, data, specifications, drawings, or calculations are to be submitted to City authorities for their approval.
- **SECTION 4**. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 5**. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to insure engineering services at the earliest possible time, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
