A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT A GRANT AWARDED FROM THE OHIO OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE TO THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR BODY WORN CAMERAS UP TO THE AMOUNT OF FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$15,000.00).

WHEREAS, The Reminderville Police Department has made application for and has been awarded a Grant in the amount of \$15,000.00 for body worn cameras, therefore,

NOW BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Council hereby accepts the Grant in the amount of up to fifteen thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$15,000.00) awarded from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services to the Reminderville Police Department.

SECTION 2: That Council hereby authorizes and directs the Police Chief to take all steps necessary to receive such grant.

SECTION 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
