RESOLUTION 22-2022: A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION FROM THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND REVOKE THE POLICE COMMISSION OF CARA WILSON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 1st Reading. *Alonso*

RESOLUTION 23-2022: A RESOLUTION TO PROMOTE PATRICK MANNION TO SHIFT LEADER FOR THE REMINDERVILLE ATHLETIC CLUB AND TO BE PAID AN HOURLY RATE OF ELEVEN DOLLARS AND 33/100 (\$11.33), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. 1st Reading. *DiCarlo*

He asked Council to think about it and they will discuss at a further meeting.
