A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 105-2018 WHICH CONFIRMED THE TERMINATION OF CARA WILSON AS A REMINDERVILLE POLICE OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined there is good cause to repeal Resolution no. 105-2018, therefore,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 105-2018 stating that Cara Wilson shall be terminated is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council. If this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
