AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 139.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE, ENTITLED "COMPOSITION", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is a need to amend Section 139.01 of the Codified Ordinances, therefore;

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit. State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 139.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Reminderville which presently reads as follows:

139.01 COMPOSITION.

- (a) The Police Department shall consist of a Chief of Police who shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by Council.
- (b) The Police Department shall consist of more than nine (9) full-time patrolmen and Detective(s).
- (c) In addition to the nine (9) full-time patrolmen and Detective(s), the following ranks and positions may be filled by appointment by the Mayor subject to confirmation by Council:
 - (1) Captain.
 - (2) Lieutenant.
 - (3) Sergeant.
 - (4) Administrative Secretary/Clerk of Court.
 - (d) Full Time Employees.
 - (1) Work a total of eighty (80) hours during a two week pay period.
 - (2) All are non-exempt (eligible for overtime) except the Chief of Police.
 - (e) The Police Department shall consist of no more than five (5) part-time patrolmen.
 - (1) Part-time patrolmen may work full-time hours during the summer months and at other periods, as needed.
 - (2) May purchase their own medical and health insurance benefits.

shall be amended to read as follows:

139.01 COMPOSITION.

- (a) The Police Department shall consist of a Chief of Police who shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by Council.
- (b) The Police Department shall consist of no more than ten (10) full-time patrolmen and Detective(s).
- (c) In addition to the ten (10) full-time patrolmen and Detective(s), the following ranks and positions may be filled by appointment by the Mayor subject to confirmation by Council:

- (1) Captain.
- (2) Lieutenant.
- (3) Sergeant.
- (4) Administrative secretary/Clerk of Court.
- (d) Full Time Employees.
 - (1) Work a total of 80 hours during a two week pay period.
 - (2) All are non-exempt (eligible for overtime) except the Chief of Police.
- (e) The Police Department shall consist of no more than five (5) part-time patrolmen.
- (1) Part-time patrolmen may work full-time hours during the summer months and at other periods, as needed.
 - (2) May purchase their own medical and health insurance benefits.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure immediate placement, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
