

RESOLUTION NO. 38-2022

OFFERED BY: Mayor Alonso

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR TO SELL TO TWINSBURG TOWNSHIP A DITCH MOWER AND ATTACHMENTS AT A PRICE NOT TO EXCEED SEVEN THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$7,500.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Reminderville owns a ditch mower and some attachments that it no longer needs, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Twinsburg Township has expressed its desire to purchase the ditch mower and the attachments from the City, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to sell to Twinsburg Township one ditch mower and its attachments at a price not to exceed seven thousand five hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$7,500.00).

SECTION 2. That a copy of the Proof of Sale shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville to wit: said amendment is for the benefit of the residents of the City of Reminderville. If this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
