AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT DIFFER FROM THOSE PROVIDED BY GENERAL LAW FOR THE HIRING OF POLICE PATROL OFFICERS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

- **WHEREAS,** Section 10.04 of the Charter of the City of Reminderville permits the Civil Service Commission, with the approval of Council by ordinance, to adopt rules and regulations that differ from those provided by general law; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Civil Service Commission has met and discussed this matter during a meeting and recommends amending the rules and regulations for the hiring process of police patrol officers, subject to approval by Council; and
- **NOW, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:
- **SECTION 1.** That pursuant to Section 10.04 of the Charter of the City of Reminderville, the Civil Service Commission is hereby authorized and directed to amend its rules for the hiring and selection process for the position of police patrol officer in accordance with their Proposed Amendment to Civil Service Rules attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Civil Service Commission if further authorized to adopt any further ministerial regulations necessary to implement and carry out the approved rules and which are not inconsistent herewith.
- **SECTION 3.** That by adopting the aforesaid rules and regulations, those portions of the general civil service law inconsistent herewith are inapplicable to the hiring and selection process for police patrol officers and are hereby null and void.
- **SECTION 4**. That the additions/amendments to the Rules of Civil Service marked Exhibit A are attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- **SECTION 5.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 6.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville to wit: said amendment is for the benefit of the residents of the City of Reminderville. If this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
