

RESOLUTION NO. 45-2022

A RESOLUTION TO HIRE DERRICK COOK AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER ON PROBATION WITH THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO BE PAID AT THE RATE OF TWENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND 59/100 (\$23.59) PER HOUR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief represents that Derrick Cook has satisfied all requirements necessary to become a Part-Time Police Officer on probation in the Reminderville Police Department except for completing a polygraph, and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended hiring Derrick Cook to the position of Part-Time Police Officer on probation in the Reminderville Police Department contingent upon Derrick Cook passing the polygraph, and

WHEREAS, if Derrick Cook does not pass the polygraph, this Resolution becomes null and void, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is good cause to accept the recommendation of the Police Chief, therefore:

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Derrick Cook is hereby hired to the position of Part-Time Police Officer on probation in the Reminderville Police Department once he passes a polygraph, to be paid at a rate of \$23.59 per hour effective June 13, 2022.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure shift coverage, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
