

ORDINANCE NO. 31-2022

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 123.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE ENTITLED “POSTING PLACES”, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that there is a need to amend Section 123.01 of the Codified Ordinances, therefore,

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 123.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Reminderville which presently reads as follows:

123.01 POSTING PLACES.

The following is hereby designated as the five public posting locations of resolutions and ordinances passed by Council:

- (a) The northwest corner of California Street and Glenwood Avenue;
- (b) Between California and Florida Streets on the north side of East Boulevard;
- (c) The City Hall located at 3382 Glenwood Avenue;
- (d) On the southwest corner of Lake Street and Connecticut Avenue; and
- (e) 3500 Tradewinds at the pool house.

Shall be amended to read as follows:

123.01 POSTING PLACES.

The following are hereby designated as the two public posting locations of agendas, resolutions and ordinances passed by Council:

- (a) Reminderville City Hall located at 3382 Glenwood Boulevard
- (b) City of Reminderville website located at www.reminderville.com

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville to wit: said amendment is for the benefit of the residents of the City of Reminderville. If this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
