

**ORDINANCE NO. 33-2022**

**OFFERED BY: Mayor Alonso**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE “ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND” SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO PROPERLY TRACK INCOMING MONIES AND APPROVED PURPOSES AS REQUIRED BY THE ONEOHIO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.**

**WHEREAS**, Council has determined that there is good cause to create a new fund titled “OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund” for the purpose of properly tracking incoming monies and approved purposes as required by the OneOhio MOU.

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** The Finance Director is hereby directed to create a special revenue fund within the accounts of the City of Reminderville and to name such fund the “OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund”.

**SECTION 2.** The purpose of the fund is to properly track incoming monies and approved purposes as required by the OneOhio MOU.

**SECTION 3.** Interest earned to this fund shall be handled in accordance with governing law.

**SECTION 4.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 5.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
