

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS PROVIDED THROUGH THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$45,000.00) TO OFFSET THE NEGATIVE ECONOMIC IMPACT TO THE REMINDERVILLE ATHLETIC CLUB DUE TO LOSS OF REVENUE CAUSED BY THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Treasury Department has granted the City of Reminderville with funds through the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”), and

**WHEREAS**, the Reminderville Athletic Club (RAC) lost revenue due to the COVID-19 Pandemic in Fiscal Years 2020, 2021, and 2022, and

**WHEREAS**, one of the permitted expenditures of the ARPA funds is to replace lost public sector revenue, using this funding up to the amount of revenue lost due to the pandemic, therefore,

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** Funds in the amount of forty-five thousand dollars and 00/100 (\$45,000.00) will be allocated to the RAC to offset the negative economic impact to the RAC due to loss of revenue caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

**SECTION 2.** Sufficient funds are available in fund 2151 Local Coronavirus Relief Fund.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville to wit: to ensure polices are in place in a timely fashion. If this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
