

**RESOLUTION NO. 59-2022**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING OHM ADVISORS' DETAILED COST ESTIMATE PURSUANT TO OHM ADVISORS' ENGINEERING STUDY OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE FOR GLENWOOD GREENS TO BE CONSIDERED FOR STREET DEDICATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Reminderville Codified Ordinance Section 1119.01, and upon formal written request and appropriate deposit by Glenwood Greens HOA and Glenwood Green Cluster Development Replat HOA, and

**WHEREAS**, OHM Advisors conducted a formal study of the existing infrastructure and prepared a detailed cost estimate including the costs for the street dedication process; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Reminderville Codified Ordinance Section 1119.01(f)(4)(C), Council shall review and approve or deny the City Engineer's detailed cost estimate; therefore,

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** Council approves OHM's detailed cost estimate analyzing the costs associated with dedicating private streets within Glenwood Greens and the Glenwood Greens Replat developments.

**SECTION 2.** Said detailed cost estimate is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to provide for the timeliness of the request, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
