WHEREAS, the City of Reminderville Police Department has an occasional need to use jail space in other jurisdictions to house City of Reminderville prisoners; and therefore,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute and enter into an Agreement with the City of Macedonia for the housing of prisoners for the period enumerated in the Agreement.

SECTION 2. That a copy of such Agreement shall be attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to insure timely passage, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
