AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 141.15 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE REGARDING FIRE DEPARTMENT OVERTIME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined there is a need to amend Section 141.15 of the Codified Ordinances effective January 1, 2022, therefore,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Section 141.15 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Reminderville which presently reads as follows:

141.15 OVERTIME.

(a) Fire department employees will be paid overtime at one and one-half their current hourly rate for each hour worked in excess of 106 hours per pay period.

- (b) Attendance at departmental meetings and/or training during off duty hours will be paid at the firefighters' regular rate of pay.
- (c) Except for responses to emergencies, no member will work overtime hours without prior approval of the Fire Chief or Officer in Charge.

shall be amended to read as follows:

141.15 OVERTIME.

- (a) Fire department employees will be paid overtime at one and one-half their current hourly rate for each hour worked in excess of 106 hours per pay period.
- (b) Attendance at departmental meetings and/or training during off duty hours will be paid at the firefighters' regular rate of pay.
- (c) Except for responses to emergencies, no member will work overtime hours without prior approval of the Fire Chief or Officer in Charge.
- (d) With prior approval of the Fire Chief of the Officer in Charge, in certain circumstances, fire department employees may be paid overtime at two (2) times their current hourly rate of pay.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort,

convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville to wit: said amendment is for the benefit of the residents of the City of Reminderville. If this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
