

**RESOLUTION NO. 69-2022**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING WEST CREEK CONSERVANCY'S CLEAN OHIO GREEN SPACE CONSERVATION PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE POND BROOK AURORA LAKE PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the West Creek Conservancy intends to submit a grant application for the conservation of the Pond Brook Aurora Lake Project (the "Project") which would preserve property along Glenwood Boulevard, in the City of Reminderville, to the Ohio Public Works Commission and the District 8 Natural Resources Assistance Council for funding through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program (the "Clean Ohio Grant Application"); and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Public Works Commission, administers financial assistance for the acquisition of open spaces, through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program; and

**WHEREAS**, preservation of the Project's natural riparian corridors, high-quality wetlands, and functioning floodplains will help protect and maintain ground water supplies and water quality in the area; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the City of Reminderville to declare its support for the West Creek Conservancy's Clean Ohio Grant Application to be submitted for funding through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program.

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** This Council hereby approves and supports the West Creek Conservancy's Clean Ohio Grant Application, in the City of Reminderville, to be submitted to the Ohio Public Works Commission and the District 8 Natural Resources Assistance Council for funding through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program, in order to conserve and preserve the Pond Brook Aurora Lake Project's property, streams, floodplains, and wetlands.

**SECTION 2.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, and for further reason that this measure is necessary due to the upcoming Clean Ohio Grant Application deadline, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
