## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 45-2022, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Council has determined that there is a need to amend Ordinance 45-2022, therefore,

**NOW, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That language be added to Ordinance 45-2022 as follows:

The Reminderville Athletic Club personnel shall be paid no less than the minimum wage of \$10.10 per hour and personnel currently paid more than minimum wage shall have their hourly pay rate increased by 3%.

**SECTION 2.** The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: said Ordinance is for the benefit of the residents of the City of Reminderville, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
