

RESOLUTION NO. 05-2023

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH LIBERTY FORD AURORA FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2022 FORD F-250 TRUCK FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT-HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$26,872.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Department Supervisor has recommended to Council that there is a need to purchase a new truck for use by the Service Department, and

WHEREAS, the trade-in value of the Service Department 2015 Ford F250 truck in the amount of twenty-five thousand five-hundred dollars and 00/100 (\$25,500.00) has been deducted from the original purchase amount for the 2022 Ford F-250 Truck of forty-nine thousand nine hundred ninety dollars and 00/100 (\$49,990.00),

WHEREAS, Council has good cause to accept the recommendation of the Service Department Supervisor,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Liberty Ford Aurora for the purchase of a 2022 Ford F-250 Truck for a sum not to exceed twenty-six thousand eight-hundred seventy-two dollars and 00/100 (\$26,872.00),

SECTION 2. That a copy of the Purchase Agreement shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to insure that the vehicle is purchased in a timely fashion, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
