## A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH OHIO CATERPILLAR TO TRADE A 2019 BACKHOE TO FACILITATE THE PURCHASE OF A 2023 SKID LOADER IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$5,470.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Department Supervisor has recommended to Council that there is a need to trade in the City's 2019 Cat Backhoe 420F to facilitate the purchase of a 2023 Cat 262d3 Skid Loader for use by the Service Department, and

**WHEREAS**, Council has good cause to accept the recommendation of the Service Department Supervisor,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Ohio Caterpillar to trade in the City's 2019 Cat Backhoe 420F, purchase a 2023 Cat 262d3 Skid Loader, and pay the difference of the amount not to exceed five thousand four hundred seventy dollars and 00/100 (\$5,470.00).

**SECTION 2.** That a copy of the Trade-In Agreement/subsequent Purchase Agreement shall be attached hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4**. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to facilitate the purchase at the earliest possible time, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
