A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MARGARET LAMBROSA TO THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there exists a vacancy on the Civil Service Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has submitted the appointment of Margaret Lambrosa to fill such vacant position, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to confirm the appointment of Margaret Lambrosa to the vacant position on the Civil Service Commission for the term ending 12/31/2024, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the appointment of Margaret Lambrosa to the Civil Service Commission is hereby confirmed.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to submit the Participation Form by the deadline, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
