

RESOLUTION NO. 63-2023

AN RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GAMETIME FOR THE PURCHASE OF INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FOR USE IN RAY WILLIAMS PARK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND 50/100 (\$386,258.50), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council recognizes the need to update the playground equipment at Ray Williams Park; and

WHEREAS, GameTime has provided the City with an opportunity to purchase inclusive playground equipment at a reasonable and discounted price; and therefore,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with GameTime for the purchase of inclusive playground equipment for use in Ray Williams Park as noted on the attached purchase agreement, referenced thereof and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That the total purchase price of the inclusive playground equipment shall not exceed three hundred eighty-six thousand two hundred fifty-eight dollars and 50/100 (\$386,258.50).

SECTION 3. That appropriations for such purchase are needed in Fund 2073 and Fund 2151.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to provide for purchase at the earliest possible date, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
