### **Call to Order**

### **Approval of Minutes**

Mr. DiCarlo moved to approve the minutes from October 10, 2023. Mr. Putnam seconded. All in favor.

The committee went through the payment register.

Mr. Putnam moved to accept payments totaling \$350,825.03. Mr. Milani seconded. All in favor.

Ms. Rockhill presented her 2024 budget for the RAC. She would like to create a new position that would combine office hours and latchkey lead due to the resignation of Debbie Hybil and Patti Goodnight. Her personnel services would increase more than the standard 3% as she would like to incorporate a new pay scale for the RAC employees. The new pay scale would be based on years of service and would be a one-time based adjustment to set the employees at a fair rate going forward. The revenue projections are lower due to programs like latchkey declining in attendance. The expenditure projections increased due to building repairs.

### **Unfinished Business**

Mr. DiCarlo reported he received a call from Chief Plunkett regarding a new pumper truck. In 2021 a price for a custom pumper as they have now was \$585,000; as of January 2023, the price is \$800,000. If ordered today, the pumper would take 30-36 months to get it. There are options to pick a spec truck for \$730,000 with 12-18 months to get. A new rescue squad would be \$275,000-\$300,000 and he will be looking to purchase in the coming years.
