

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, these appropriations have been made in keeping with projected revenues for 2024, now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That to provide for the expenditures of said City during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024, the attached sums be set aside and appropriated:

**SECTION 7.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure immediate placement, and if this Ordinance receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
