

RESOLUTION NO. 36-2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR ALONSO TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY TO ADD ADDITIONAL STREETS TO THE MULTI STREET PAVING PROJECT IN AN ADDED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND FOURTEEN DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$95,014.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, OHM has recommended to Council for the City of Reminderville that there is additional money available from the OPWC grant to add Meriden Court and Crisfield Court to the 2024 Multi Street Paving Project previously awarded to Perrin Asphalt; and therefore,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the City of Reminderville hereby adds Meriden Court and Crisfield Court to the 2024 Multi Street Paving Project in an added amount not to exceed ninety-five thousand fourteen dollars and 00/100 (\$95,014.00).

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to insure the project begins at the earliest possible time, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
