A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF ANTON WILLIAMS FROM THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT, EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Anton Williams has tendered his resignation from the Reminderville Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to accept the resignation of Anton Williams from the Reminderville Fire Department, now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, and State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the resignation of Anton Williams from the Reminderville Fire Department, effective June 30, 2024, is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to keep staffing levels balanced, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
