

RESOLUTION NO. 60-2024

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE SUMMIT COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council, in accordance with the provisions of law, has previously adopted a tax budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Summit County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Fiscal Officer of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within, the 10-mill limitation, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the amounts and rates as indicated by the Budget Commission and County Fiscal Officer, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. That there be and there is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of the City the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the 10-mill limitation, as is indicated in the exhibit that is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. That the City Finance Director is authorized and directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to the County Fiscal Officer and Budget Commission prior to the deadline specified by the Fiscal Officer for certifying such rates.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to provide for the application of funds for the construction of improvements, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
