

**RESOLUTION NO. 61-2024**

**OFFERED BY: Mayor Alonso**

**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF TWINSBURG TO PROVIDE DISPATCH SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reminderville has a need for dispatch services for the Police and Fire Departments, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Reminderville desires to enter into a four (4) year agreement with the City of Twinsburg for the City of Twinsburg to provide dispatch services to the City of Reminderville, and

**WHEREAS**, the amounts of compensation each year for dispatch services to the City of Twinsburg will be: 2025: \$84,405.20; 2026: \$86,093.30; 2027: \$89,537.03; 2028: \$93,118.51, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the City of Twinsburg to provide dispatch services for the Police and Fire Departments for the period December 1, 2024, though and including November 30, 2028.

**SECTION 2.** That the costs to the City of Reminderville for dispatch services from the City of Twinsburg for the next four (4) years will be 2025: \$84,405.20; 2026: \$86,093.30; 2027: \$89,537.03; 2028: \$93,118.51.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure no lapse in services, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
