A RESOLUTION APPOINTING BETH PAJEMOLA TO THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE FINANCE COMMITTEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there exists a vacancy on the Finance Committee due to the resignation of Robert Putnam, and

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to confirm Mayor Alonso's appointment of Beth Pajemola to fill such vacant position, therefore,

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Beth Pajemola is hereby appointed to the Finance Committee effective November 13, 2024 through the term ending December 31, 2025.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure that the Finance Committee has a sufficient number of members to carry out its duties, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
