

**RESOLUTION NO. 64-2024**

**OFFERED BY: Mayor Alonso**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REMINDERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE OHIO BODY WORN CAMERA GRANT PROGRAM AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio offers financial assistance for police departments in purchasing body worn cameras through the Ohio Body Worn Camera Grant Program, and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department of the City of Reminderville desires the financial assistance of the Program, and is eligible to apply for a grant that reimburses 100% of expenditures for body worn cameras,

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of this Council to authorize the Reminderville Police Department to apply for said grant from the Ohio Body Worn Camera Grant Program; to further authorize Mayor Alonso to accept the grant if awarded, and to execute a contract with the Program if required; and to authorize the Reminderville Police Department to execute all other non-contract documents necessary to effectuate receipt of the grant, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the Reminderville Police Department is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from the Ohio Body Worn Camera Program.

**SECTION 2.** That Mayor Alonso is authorized to accept said grant, if awarded, on behalf of the City of Reminderville and to execute a contract with the Program, if required; and that the Reminderville Police Department is authorized to execute all other non-contract documents necessary to effectuate receipt of the grant.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure application in a timely fashion, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
