

RESOLUTION NO. 73-2024

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A&S ANIMAL CONTROL TO PROVIDE ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES IN THE CITY OF REMINDERVILLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council finds good cause to renew the agreement with A&S Animal Control Services for the 2025-2027 agreement term; and

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Reminderville, County of Summit, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with A & S Animal Control to provide animal control services for the City for the term January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2027.

SECTION 2. That a copy of such agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal action by this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, comfort, convenience, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Reminderville, to wit: to ensure timely services, and if this Resolution receives the necessary number of votes, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
